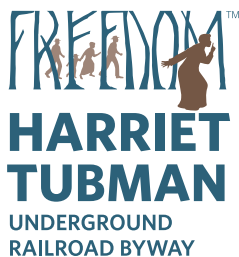
Musical Tribute to Harriet Tubman
